

# Eli Lilly team up with the Wiltshire Wildlife Trust in a “win-win” community project

The National Sales Management Team from Eli Lilly, whose UK headquarters is in Basingstoke, devoted their considerable energies on 3 July to supporting a major conservation project at Pewsey near Marlborough in Wiltshire.

The team of 55 gathered from around the UK to roll up their sleeves on behalf of the Wiltshire Wildlife Trust. They spent the day using railway sleepers to develop new pathways around the Jones’s Mill nature reserve, a Site of Special Scientific Interest on the banks of the Kennet and Avon Canal in between Marlborough and Amesbury. Jones’ Mill is Wiltshire’s only fenland nature reserve with a unique wetland habitat.

Iain Boyd from the Wiltshire Wildlife Trust says: “The offer of help from Eli Lilly’s National Sales Management Team has made possible something we have long wanted to achieve – the opportunity to open up new parts of the Jones’ Mill reserve which can be very boggy and inaccessible when rain falls.
