The Employee Volunteering Community Coaching and Mentoring Project is an ambitious and innovative approach to tackling some of these "big issues". Through the application of a Level 3 coaching and mentoring certificate accredited by the Institute of Leadership and Management, it links priority people from the local community with business professionals who are looking to advance their management skills to the most sophisticated level.

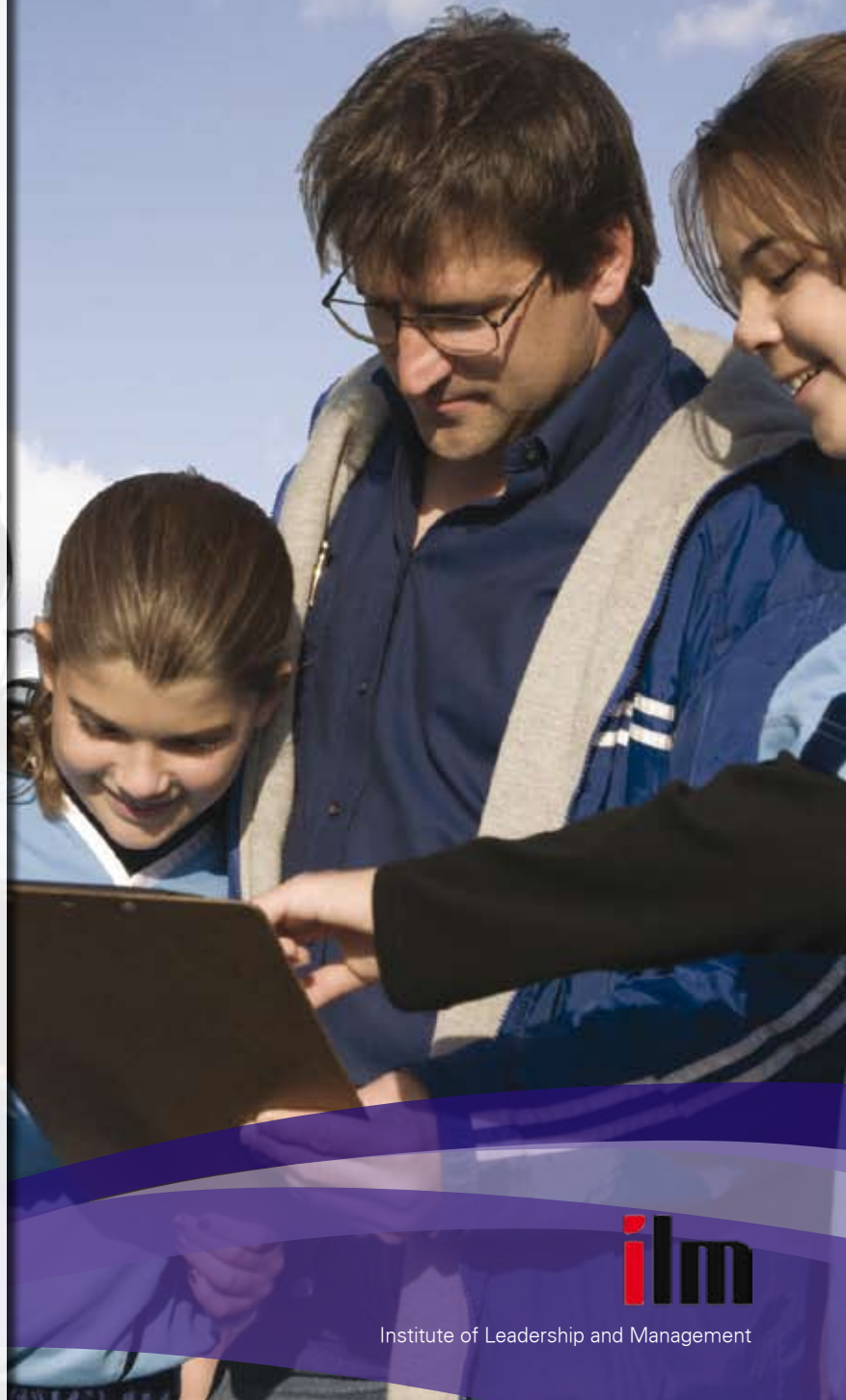
The project represents a huge challenge for individual members of your staff. Each employee will gain their ILM coaching certificate by supporting three local people over a 12-month period – offering the sort of consistency and attention that they may not have experienced before. With this level of support, those being coached can gain confidence, raise their aspirations and personal effectiveness and, ultimately, increase their own contribution to the economy of the local community. The project also includes a 4 day residential workshop at a choice of water sports or rural activity centres provided by our partners. Employees who successfully complete this project will have invaluable skills for future application in the workplace.
