A Community Based Team Building Initiative


Delivering huge benefits to **your** business, **your** employees and **your** community.

Employee Volunteering (EV) Youth Engagement Projects are a Team Building opportunity that encourages leadership qualities and develops communication and team work skills within your organisation. They are community based projects held during the school summer holidays to provide activity days for young people. These activity days provide a diversion facility for young people, predominantly from social housing or challenging backgrounds, to encourage them away from anti-social behaviour. Youth Engagement Projects can significantly reduce anti social behaviour and criminal damage reports in the communities in which they operate. The Projects are organised in partnership with youth services, schools, the police, local social housing associations and the community Local Strategic Partnership.

They can be linked to the educational charity ASDAN, so children who might be losing interest in school can enjoy Youth Engagement Projects and gain credits towards a key skills GCSE.

The Projects also provide excellent opportunities for businesses to engage with young people in the community and an exceptionally cost effective team building opportunity for up to 20 staff.
